Part of a national organization began in 1887, the Milwaukee Chapter was founded in 1948. Each year, our all-volunteer membership works through our Follow the Child Programs to help serve children in need in our community.

LAYETTES

We procure, assemble, and distribute newborn clothing and basic supplies to mothers with infants in need through partnerships with area hospitals and care centers.

MY STUFF BAGS

We procure, assemble, and distribute clothing, hygiene, and comfort items to children who are unexpectedly placed in temporary housing shelters for safety.

VISION SCREENING


Our volunteers partnered with Prevent Blindness to screen 880 parochial elementary students in 2024.

SCHOOL SUPPORT & LITERACY

Program support provided to St. Joan Antida, Messmer, and St. Colletta's Day School. Volunteer teaching assistance for Blessed Savior School South students, and small book libraries provided and stocked at local homeless shelters.

SECOND SATURDAY

Volunteers provide a safe environment for mothers and children to gather and grow in community. Programming includes activities, crafts, reading, speakers, and lunch.
